WELCOME:

Norwegian Cruise Line enthusiastically welcomes families and children onboard our ships, and has designed a special program to make this cruise an enjoyable experience for the entire family. In order to give parents those needed moments alone and at the same time know that their children are not only safe but are having fun, the youth programs offer qualified staff and a variety of activities.

Everyday, children ages 2-12 can participate in complimentary activities designed especially for them. Don't think this is a baby-sitting program – there's very little sitting involved! Our activities are active, energetic, educational, and most important, fun. Kids will get involved in arts and crafts, trivias, sports, theme nights, games and parties – activities that will challenge both their imagination and determination.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Parents/Guardian must register the child who is 2-12 years of age, in order for them to participate in the morning, afternoon and evening programs.
- All parents/guardian must complete the registration form.
- Identification bracelets will be used at ALL times for ages 2-12. Bracelets are required for both the day and evening programs.
- NO child under age 13 may sign themselves out of the program and walk through the ship unattended.
- Older brothers and sisters (unless 21 years or older and who have signed the registration form) may not sign out a young family member, under the age of 13.
- Parents must present a means of identification that has a signature; the signature must match that of the registration form. When the Youth Counselor KNOWS the family member it is not necessary to check each time.
- Parents with children in diapers or pull-ups will be issued beepers in order to notify them when a change is necessary or the child requires attention.

SAFETY:

In the event of an emergency during the program hours, the Child Care Team is responsible for mustering the children in their care and bringing them safely to the Child Muster Station, where the children will be claimed by their parents. All unclaimed children will be taken to the Child Standby Muster Station then distributed to their assigned lifeboat station. The team will distribute children and infants life jackets and assist in their correct wearing.

INTERNET:

For your convenience we have 24 hour Internet Services available in the Internet Café. Here is where you can email, chat online with your friends at home, access your AOL account and surf the net. Basic Time Charge is .75 per minute or see the Internet Manager for the great plans we have to offer.

Parents: If you do not wish your child to have Internet access, please see the Internet Café Manager to de-activate his/her account.

NCLA KIDS' CREW

Although the inside of the program listed the basic program requirements, there are a few additional specifics you need to know. If you have any questions, feel free to speak with the Youth Program Supervisor.

- Children are assigned to their appropriate age group based on the age at sailing, and the ship's manifest. It is for the safety of all participants that children are not allowed to switch age groups. We regret that no exceptions can be made.
- Activities may be altered to accommodate the needs of the children that participate at any time.
- Our phone number is 12510.
- Our programs are very active, and for the safety of your child, proper footwear is required. No flip-flops or sandals, please.
- Youth Staff are not able to assist children in the washrooms and do not change Diapers or Pull-Ups under any circumstance.
- Our handy phones do not work ashore, therefore any parents with children requiring a handy phone will not be allowed to leave the vessel if a child is in program or group sitting.
- Children with any symptoms of illness may be required to see the medical center before being admitted to the program.
- Parent Pick-Up Times are very important, as the Youth Staff have other duties and responsibilities as part of the Cruise Director's Staff.
- Light snacks are often served during our programs so it is imperative that all allergies and medications are noted on registration forms.
- All activities underlined are for the whole family and a parent is required to attend in order for child to participate.
- Youth Staff is not included in onboard gratuities.

SAFETY SPECIFICS & EMERGENCY INFORMATION

As stated on the inside page, in the event of an emergency situation during program times, parents are to pick up their children at the Child Muster Station E, Midship, in Le Bistro. (If Station E is unavailable, please pick up your children at Muster Station D in the Medusa Lounge.) Once the abandon ship alarm is sounded, any children not picked up will be placed into lifeboats with the youth staff.

To inquire about a lifejacket for your child, please speak to your stateroom steward.

We also ask that you and your children are aware of the ship's rules and regulations as stated on the cover of the Freestyle Daily.

LATE NIGHT GROUP SITTING & PORT PLAY

"Late Night Group Sitting" and "Port Play" are both group-sitting services, run by the Youth Staff. All activities take place in the Kids' Crew facilities, and all the requirements and procedures apply. The charge for this service is \$5.00 per hour, per child, and \$3.00 for each additional sibling in the same immediate family. Charges are applied directly to your onboard account. Families wishing to use these services must be signed up by 8:00pm the night of desired Late Night Group Sitting, and 8:00pm the evening prior to desired Port Play, for these services to run. Please see a member of the Youth Staff at the Kids' Crew facility to sign up.

YOUTH PROGRAM DISCIPLINE POLICY

We use a four-step Discipline Policy to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all the children that participate in our program. It is strictly enforced and we appreciate your cooperation and kind understanding.

Step 1: Warning: The Youth Counselor addresses the child and it is explained that his/her behavior is unacceptable and needs to be improved immediately.

Step 2: Time Out: If the child continues to disobey the Youth Counselor, a time out is issued and the parents are notified at pick up time.

Step 3: Suspension: If a time out is not effective in eliminating the inappropriate behavior, the parents are located and the child is grounded from the program for 24 hours. The child is then welcomed back, but if there is any reservation on the part of the Youth Counselor, a parent may be required to attend with their child.

Step 4: Dismissal: Once the child is allowed back into the program after the initial dismissal, if any disobedient behavior continues, the child will no longer be allowed to participate.

Please be advised that we also offer an Under 2 Zoo. This is a location where parents can bring their children under the age of 2 to play with age-appropriate toys and games. The Under 2 Zoo is located in the Cinema on Deck 12, Midship. For access, turn left just before reaching the entrance to the Keiki Kids Club, proceed down the hallway towards the Wipe Out Club, and enter through the door marked "Cinema". The Under 2 Zoo will be open every day, and the hours will be stated in your Freestyle Daily. Please note that children under the age of 2 are not permitted in the Keiki Kids Club for safety reasons. Thank you for your understanding, and enjoy the Under 2 Zoo!
